with Jesus Christ this year!

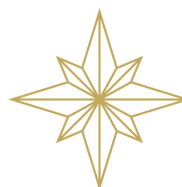
I hear the many Christmas songs

To hear an angel sing!

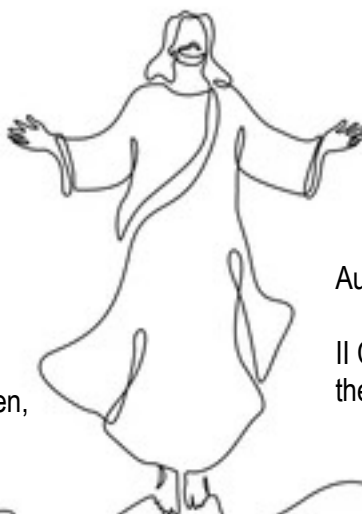
I can't tell you of the splendor
